Begin the "Initial command" box with this sentence: "fill in this blank medical template based on the transcript below:" then paste your blank template below it.

Include these commands in the "optional formatting" box to give the AI clearer instructions on your desired format:

- To make the titles bold put **Bold each title in the template** or **put 2 asterisks on the left and right of each title**
- To have simplified results put *provide a brief and clear response*
- To write a brief and concise history: Write a short, concise Subjective/history
- To have more detailed results put *provide a detailed response*
- To have a summary at the end of the note put **generate a summary at the end of the note**
- For discharge instructions put generate discharge instructions at the end
- To make a list put write out every section as a list except for the subjective
- Signature at the end put add the following signature at the end of the note signature
- To separate sections put separate each section into appropriate subsections
- To change the default values into abnormal findings put *replace default normal values* with abnormalities mentioned in the transcript
- To write the assessment section in bullet points put Write the assessment section in bullet points
- To add a rule out (r/o) statement for the assessment put Write a rule out statement (R/o) under each bullet point in the assessment
- To make a problem list put write a problem list for the assessment section
- To add 'Rx' beside each medication put Write 'Rx-' beside each bullet point for Medications
- Make all abnormal findings capitalized
- Put an open and closed bracket on each side of the titles
- Write Mg per MI as mg/mI
- Write Mg per Kg as mg/kg
- Convert layman's terms to medical terms
